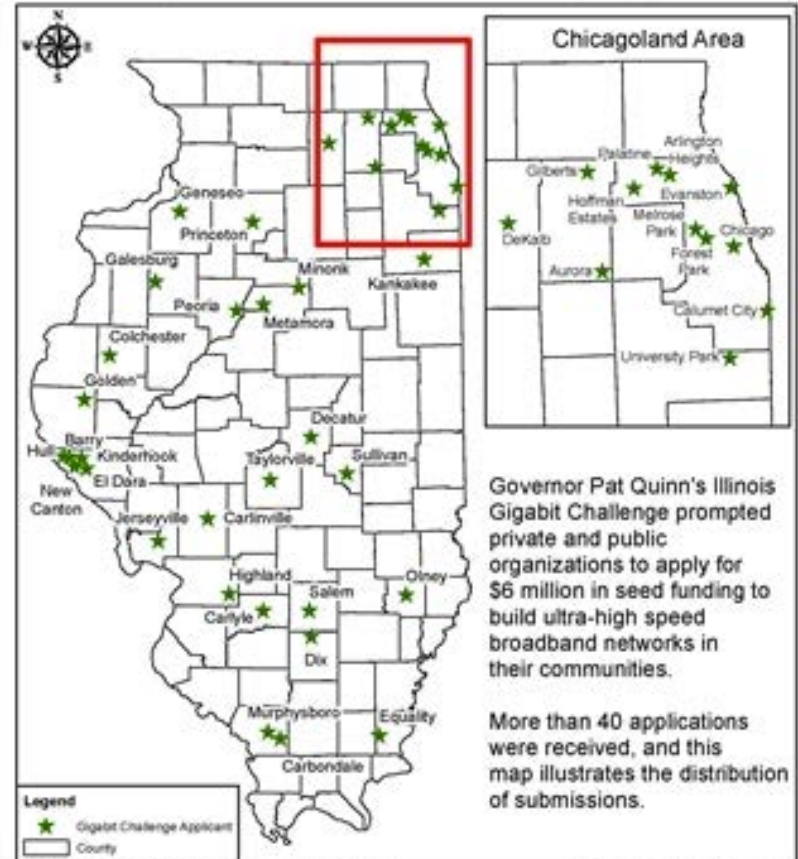
Governor's Gigabit Challenge

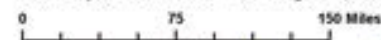
