- 1. **Nursing Homes access issue**: especially in the Peoria area, they also need to understand how to get access, Nursing home emergency management is not talking, talk to local docs. EMR's with nursing homes- docs not apply to nursing homes (114 Nursing Homes in region, 31 in Peoria). The Illinois Health Care Association oversees all Nursing Homes in Illinois, and was a key partner for PCI in a survey process several years ago. - 2. **Mental Health Facilities**: (77 Mental Health facilities in region)
- 3. **Remote Workers**: Great way to attract people. Infrastructure and access. Build a business case, check areas without capacity, business, cable modem
- 4. **Morton Clinic** (435 Maxine Drive, Morton, IL 61550?): goes through two telephone services, cannot get to things, multiple T-1 lines, hurdles to finding ways around that, get metro-E services
- 5. **Video conferencing/Consolation**: Becoming a trending tool at the healthcare level.
- 6. **Iowa Health system**: Pumping a lot of bandwidth into Illinois. http://www.ihs.org/body.cfm?id=16
- 7. **Data Storage**: Storage capacity, help get a redundant fiber ring, just went live with EMR
- 8. **Central Illinois Health Information Exchange** (Joy Dulling), state funding to do health issue, Quality Qwest is the parent joined, it's just getting started, EMR by fall, opt out system. Methodist has had 25 calls about opting out, but have had 0 actual opt outs. http://cihie.org/#/our-members/4553179632
