

TELEHEALTH LEADERSHIP AWARDS SELECTION PROCESS 2021 Illinois Telehealth Initiative

Leadership Awards

Improved Care for Underserved Populations: Award for an individual or organization that incorporates virtual health care (telehealth) services in Illinois as part of an initiative resulting in improved quality of care and better value healthcare for an underserved population of patients.

Improved Policy Changes to Advance Telehealth: Award for individual or organization that demonstrate leadership and championship in Illinois in promoting and advocating for improved telehealth in policies, laws and regulations.

Advancing Telehealth by Innovation: Award for an individual or organization that advanced telehealth in Illinois through innovative:

- Technology,
- Health applications or
- Approaches to fostering partnerships and collaboration.

Leadership Award Selection Process

Partnership for a Connected Illinois (PCI) has an Awards Committee, consisting of PCI Board members, volunteers on PCI projects and representatives Telehealth Resource Center(s). The Awards Committee will seek nominations from persons/organizations active in advancing telehealth in Illinois. The Awards Committee will narrow the nominations for each award and submit those nominations to the PCI Board for final decision. Any member of the Awards Committee or the PCI Board who has any financial interest in any nominee shall refrain from voting on that nomination.

Nothing in this process shall prohibit a person from nominating a person or an organization with which he or she has a relationship, so long as that relationship is fully identified and described in the nomination form.

Schedule

Deadline for Nominations: July 1, 2021

Decision by Awards Committee on Finalists: August 1, 2021

Decision by PCI Board: August 15, 2021
