The term "**Broadband**" simply means a very fast connection to the Internet. It is a connection to the Internet that is always on and is up to **40 times faster** than the traditional dial-up access.

Follow these instructions for a quick and easy way to find out what the broadband options are for your area:

- Go to http://www.broadbandillinois.org.

 This will take you to the Broadbandillinois Home page.
- Once there, click on the "Find and Request Broadband" button located in the upper right-hand corner of the Home page.

You can also click on "search by address or zip code" on the right side of the Broadbandillinois Home page, above the map. Both actions will take you to the **Maps** tab of the Broadbandillinois web site.

- Once on the Maps tab of the Broadbandillinois web site you can search for broadband providers in your area in two ways:
 - To see a list of broadband providers in your area, enter your location (Address, zip code or latitude and longitude) in the **box at the top of the map**. Click the "**Search**" button (circled in green) to the right of the box. After you click the "Search" button, be patient, it may take a few minutes. On the right-hand side you will see a **list of available broadband providers** associated with your area. To see all of the providers on the list, scroll down using the **slider bar** on the right (circled in green).
 - To fill out a form requesting that the broadband service providers in your area contact you, use the "Want Better Options?" button. Clicking this button will take you to the "Request Broadband Service" page where you can fill out the requested information and send it to the local broadband providers by clicking the "Send Request" button on the bottom of the page.
