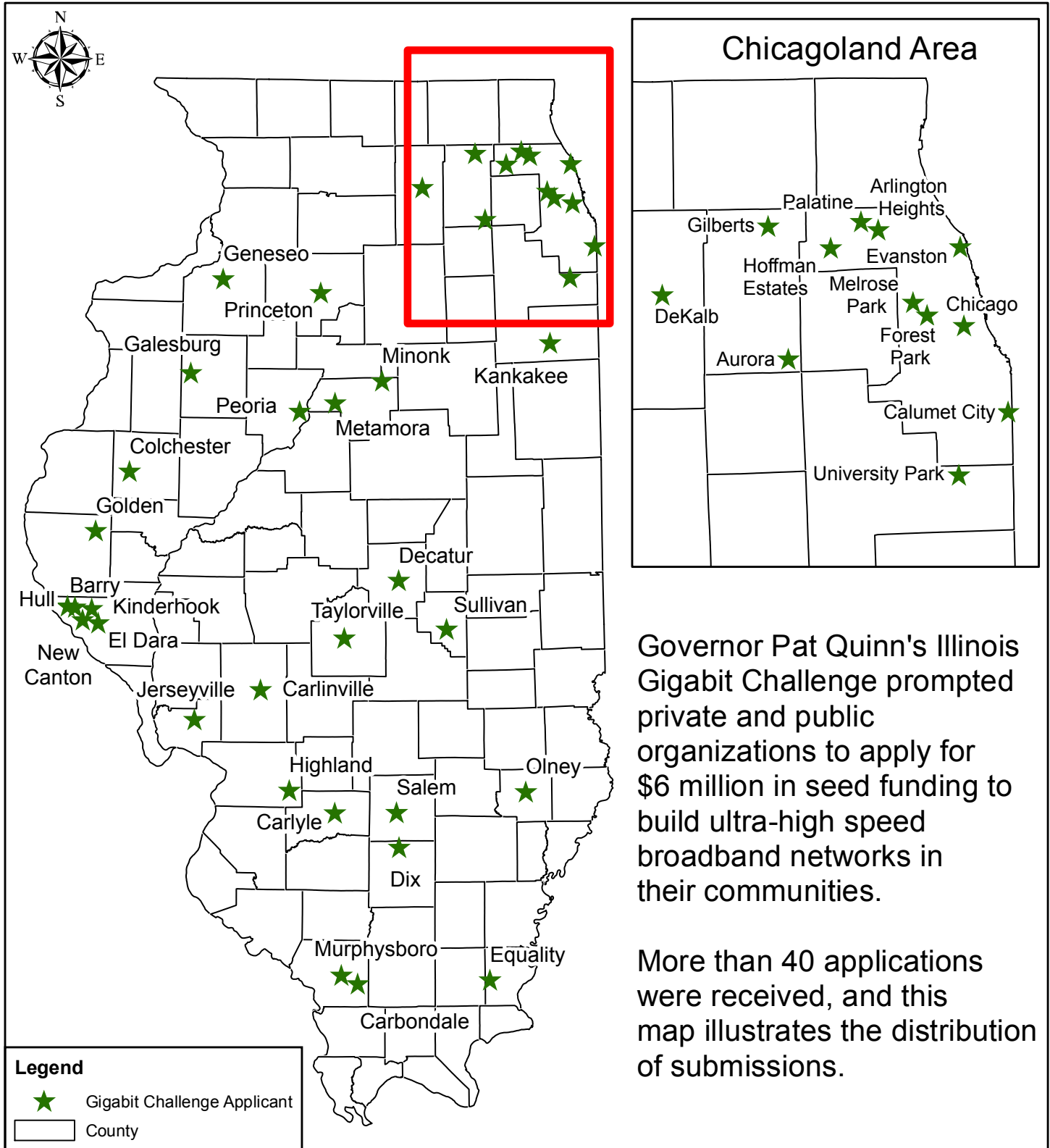




Illinois Gigabit Communities Challenge Applicants
